

As we begin the fourth week of school, we want to provide you with some additional updates and reminders:

- Distance Learning will go on at least through October 9, 2020.
- In July we had “Meet the Teacher” on two different days and 4 times. If you missed this event the teacher would be happy to share this information with you.
- School Began August 3, 2020 from home, in an all-virtual learning environment.
- Students will use a number of platforms to accomplish virtual learning. Our platform, expectations and how students will engage with their teachers will be through live zoom meetings and communication will be through Class DoJo. The learning platforms that we will be using are Savvas realize(all grade levels) and Successmaker(for 1st – 5thgrade students)
- We also post on our website: allboardcharter.com and face book page.
- We will remain all virtual until it is safe to return to school, giving parents a choice in their child’s education – either returning to classroom instruction or continuing with virtual instruction.
- Teachers have weekly parent meetings, to keep families engaged and to share ideas, solutions and support.
- Attendance is extremely import, please refer to statute A.R.S. 15-802.
- Breakfast and lunch are available for pickup from 7:00am-8:00am or 12:30pm -1:30pm. - Additional details will be made available as we move through this pandemic.

On-Site Support

Per the Governor’s Executive Order, on Monday, Aug. 17, All Aboard Charter School began offering free on-site support for the most vulnerable, high-risk students in our district who need a place to go during the school day while completing their online learning. This includes children of first responders, those with special education services, English Language Learners (ELL) or homeless and foster care students.

As we previously shared with you, on-site support does NOT include in-person instruction by a certified teacher but rather a location for our most at-risk students who do not have WiFi at home, or who do not have a safe place to go during the school day.

Currently on-site support is available at Boys and Girls Club of the valley or At Teach and Play (602)-973-1405. The hours are 7:45 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday - Thursday, and Friday 7:45 – 12:30. All families needed to register in advance to attend. Students must have their own transportation and they must be signed in and out by a parent or legal guardian every day. Breakfast and lunch will be provided at these locations.
